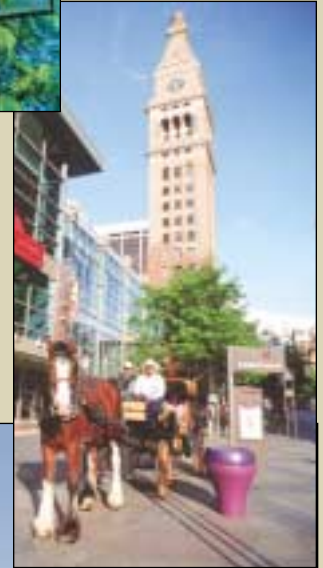


# DENVER
